

3D MAMMOGRAPHY NOW AVAILABLE

The **Dauphin Women's Center** utilizes breast tomosynthesis which is a three dimensional imaging technology that uses a low-dose short X-ray sweep around the compressed breast with only nine exposures. This imaging technique is designed to separate the tissues and to reduce the overlapping of structures, which represents a limiting factor in standard 2D mammography.

Due to its low dose and clinical accuracy, this system has the potential to replace digital mammography exams in screening to detect breast cancer.
